Penny McDonald - Chair

Dear members...thank you to all those who attended the AGM and have replied to the recent poll that we sent out.

As you may be aware, our big Lottery grant finishes at the end of April 2021. This means that \pounds 60,000 (over half of our yearly funding) including most of the payment for the Minster building lease (approx. \pounds 21,000 plus on costs) will stop.

Covid-19 has made it difficult to apply for continuation funding as most new large grant funding has been given to Covid-related projects.

Since we can't guarantee that we can afford a lease after March next year, Trustees have made the difficult decision to leave the Minster building and support staff to work from home until we are clear about what we need in the future.

The future of Lollipop...

When applying for funding it's important that Lollipop decides how we should support children and families in the future - all funders ask for this. We need to gather as much information as possible about what our members would like Lollipop to look like going forwards.

To date, we've only had 24 parents and 6 youths reply to the poll, but we have 175 families on our membership list. If you haven't replied yet, please do - it should only take 5 minutes. Lollipop staff will also be making phone calls to members, who haven't filled in the poll, to ask for their thoughts.

The most important question that we are asking is '**Should Lollipop continue**?' People replying so far definitely think it should but maybe in a different way. We will continue to discuss what this might look like at our Trustee meetings.

Music to our ears

Paul Whittaker was born in Huddersfield in 1964 and has been deaf since birth. He knew from a young age he wanted to be a musician and, after getting a music degree from Wadham College Oxford and a post-graduate diploma from the RNCM, he founded "<u>Music and the Deaf</u>" to encourage deaf people to access and enjoy music. He ran this for 27 years before leaving in 2015 to pursue a freelance career.

In 1992 Paul began signing musical shows in the West End and on tour, including Les Miserables, Cats, and West Side Story. He has appeared at the BBC Proms, Edinburgh International Festival, Aldeburgh Festival and worked with The Sixteen, Rambert Dance and Opera North.

He has been awarded honorary degrees from the University of Huddersfield and the Open University and in 2007 was given an OBE for services to Music. Paul has known about Lollipop for many years and is delighted and honoured to support their wonderful work.






