

AGM update from our Chair

A huge thank-you to parents, members and volunteers who 'Zoomed' in to join us for our Annual General Meeting on 20 October.

There have been many changes at Lollipop since I became Chair in July 2021. Staff have worked incredibly hard over a particularly difficult period to develop new ways of supporting Lollipop through remote working, and keeping in touch with members and families via our website, social media and e-newsletters.

Since <u>face-to-face activities</u> resumed last July, members have enjoyed two picnics (one with alpacas!), visits to Rainbows ceramic café, York Cocoa Works, Jorvik DIG, Tenpin Bowling, Clip 'n' Climb, Mindlock Escape Rooms, Pizza Express, Nando's, and some fully interactive and inclusive music and drama workshops!

Picture bingo and a 'sing-and-sign' with deaf musicians from the <u>I Can Play!</u> project went down a storm at our first post-lockdown Christmas party. PLUS we organised and hosted our first <u>Deaf Services Fair</u> which brought together many local charities, organisations and services for the benefit of our members, their families and the wider deaf community.

Lollipop funding update



Our main funding grants from The Lottery and Henry Smith both came to an end this year but an application for further funding from The Lottery has been submitted, and we eagerly await their decision pending approval of our proposal for the next 3 years. Meanwhile our amazing Fundraising Officers, together with our very kind sponsors and supporters, have been busy organising a whole host of fantastic fundraising activities.

The reality is that the next few months are going to be challenging for Lollipop – a small charity emerging from the pandemic and trying (like many) to survive in the current financial climate.

We will need to temporarily scale back on activities and focus all our efforts on income generation to secure Lollipop's future...

On 2 October members enjoyed a fully interactive and inclusive drama workshop with Jenna Howlett from Performance Platform Productions








Autumn puzzle
