

Lollipop parent Roy Gibson is running the Yorkshire Marathon for us in October, we are looking forward to cheering him on! Photos in the next edition!





York-based company Onebright had a team paddling for Lollipop and Place2Be in the legendary York Dragon Boat Race in July!
